

Trump Inauguration 2017

Flashing/Mooning Worksheet Instructions

Thanks citizen data scientist! You are breaking the wall of silence on flashing/mooning during a presidential inauguration. Unlike other polling methods, your efforts aren't limited to phone calls during dinner time.

Quick Instructions:

To create a flashing/mooning form, take a blank sheet of paper and fold it in half.

The top half of the blank form captures each instance of flashing/mooning with a / and for every four ///, cross them on the next one for sets of five.

The bottom half of the blank form captures **M** or **F** (if known). Use **M** or **F** in sets of four and then cross them to show sets of five.

Write your location (nearest cross streets, etc.), starting and end time on the form.

It is best to work in pairs, both for company and to increase the odds of catching every instance of flashing/mooning.

If asked, you are collecting demographics of inauguration attendance for a citizen data project. (Has the advantage of being true and yet not offensive.)
